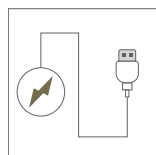
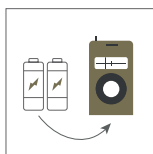
## HOW TO USE YOUR SURVIVAL KIT

This leaflet provides a summary of the instructions for using the kit. For more detailed information, read the instructions supplied with each product or visit our website:



### AM/FM RADIO

Insert the batteries and tune to the appropriate station. The radio will be a valuable source of information when an emergency also affects mobile phone coverage.

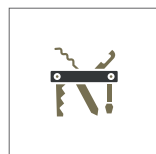


### POWER BANK

Connect it to your device using the appropriate connector. Remember to charge your power bank regularly so that it is ready when you need it. Check the charge level on the display.

### 75 HOUR CANDLE

Place the candle on a stable, heat resistant surface, away from flammable materials and out of the reach of children and pets. Never leave a burning candle unattended. Always keep it under adult supervision.

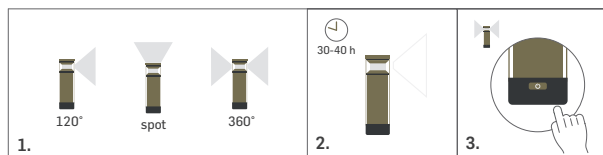


### MULTI TOOL

- Use the pliers to handle objects or hold components.
- The knife and saw are useful for cutting different materials.
- Use the screwdrivers for basic repairs.
- The can opener and bottle opener help you open containers.
- The file and awl are useful for detailed work.

### LED LAMP

1. You can use the lamp as a table lantern (360° or 120°), as a flashlight or as a red light, with both high and low power modes.
2. In low power mode, the operating time is approximately 30–40 hours.
3. Press the button to switch between the different modes. Check the condition of the batteries regularly.



# SURVIVAL KIT

## THE YSIPASA SURVIVAL KIT CONTAINS:

### POWER BANK

Battery pack for charging devices, 9,000 mAh capacity. Includes USB, USB C, Micro USB and Lightning adapters, plus a charge level display.



### LED LAMP

Compact high power LED flashlight/lantern (350 lumens). Water resistant (IPX7) up to 1 metre deep for 30 minutes. Includes lanyard and 3 AA batteries.



### MULTI TOOL

Folding pliers tool with multiple functions: knife, flat and Phillips screwdrivers, file, bottle opener, can opener, saw, awl and scissors.



### PORTABLE RADIO

Compact AM/FM radio. Includes earphones and AA batteries.



### VELA 75 HORAS

Long lasting candle made of 100% paraffin.



### XXL MATCHES

Box of 50 long matches with striking surface.



### FIRST AID KIT

| 4 adhesive dressings, 19 mm x 72 mm           | 1 pair of vinyl gloves (size M)        |
| 2 adhesive dressings, 6 cm x 1 m              | 1 saline solution, 5 ml                |
| 1 hypoallergenic adhesive tape, 1.25 cm x 5 m | 1 stainless steel scissors, 11 cm      |
| 1 single dose povidone iodine, 10 ml          | 1 bandage, 5 cm x 5 m                  |
| 2 alcohol wipes                               | 1 emergency blanket                    |



# GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS



## ACT CALMLY AND SWIFTLY

- Assess the situation and follow the instructions given by the authorities.
- If you must evacuate, take only what is essential and go to a safe place.
- Use the radio to get up to date information on the emergency.



## DURING EVACUATION

- Always carry your survival kit with you and check that it is complete.
- Make sure you have drinking water and non perishable food.
- Keep the radio on to follow official instructions.
- If possible, inform family or friends of your location.



## IF YOU HAVE TO SPEND THE NIGHT OUTDOORS

- Find shelter in a safe place, protected from the weather.
- Use the LED lamp and the candle for controlled lighting.
- The multi tool will help you with various tasks such as cutting or repairing objects.
- Save your phone battery by using the power bank efficiently.

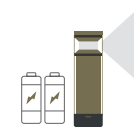

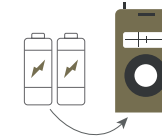
## PREPARE YOUR EMERGENCY GO BAG

Multi tool

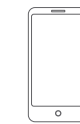


Candle and matches

Three litres of water per person per day (for at least 3 days)



Non perishable easy to prepare food (for at least 3 days)



Essential medicines and medical supplies (for at least one week)



Personal hygiene items



Copies of important documents



Emergency contact details



Warm clothing
